Set-up Information


We ask that you keep your setup confined to inside your tented area. Each expo space will be provided with the following materials:

- One (1) 8' Banquet Table
- Two (2) Folding Chairs

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Load-in Assistance

If you will need assistance moving items to your expo space/tent, please schedule a day and time with your sponsorship activation representative in advance so that we can make the appropriate arrangements.

Electrical

Please let us know of any electrical needs in advance.

Security

The tournament has two roving security guards that patrol the 18th Green area each night. If you plan to leave items of value in your expo area/tent and would like your own security guard stationed overnight, please let us know. We can provide security services for an additional fee.

Water


If you would like to have bottled water for your staff in your expo area/tent, please bring Dasani water with you during setup and leave the water bottles in your expo area. We do require that you utilize Dasani ONLY. Due to security guidelines, exhibitor staff will not be allowed to bring outside beverages onto the premises during tournament play.

Gate Entry/Security Guidelines

Please be sure to review the Prohibited Items outlined on Page 10. Exhibitor staff are required to follow the Valspar Championship & PGA TOUR's security guidelines at gate entry.

We ask that all of our guests and vendors participate in making the Valspar Championship safe and enjoyable by being aware of your surroundings. ORGANIZATION

A 20-member Board of Directors leads the nearly 200 Copperheads. Leadership is: Rondé Barber Co-General Chair, John Astrab Co-General Chair, Jim Eisch Immediate Past General Chair, and Tracy West Tournament Director.

An experienced tournament staff, 2000+ volunteers, and the Tampa Bay community all contribute to the tournament's success. Title sponsor is Valspar (paint/coatings), which is a brand owned by Sherwin-Williams.

HISTORY

The tournament is operated by a not-for-profit organization, Copperhead Charities Inc, a volunteer group of Tampa Bay area community leaders known as the Copperheads. The members have the dual ambition of raising money for charity and providing golf fans with the best in PGA TOUR competition. The organization's history of success is shown by more than \$50 million raised for charities since 1977. The event generates an estimated \$70 million economic impact annually.

The Copperheads have a 47-year history of aiding Tampa Bay area charities through professional golf. The Copperheads' first professional competition was a mixed-team event of PGA TOUR and LPGA pros in 1977. Since 2000, they have run a full field PGA TOUR event. Once held in the fall, the tournament joined the Florida swing in the spring of 2007.

Past Champions include: Taylor Moore ('23), Sam Burns ('21 & '22), Paul Casey ('18 & '19), Jordan Spieth ('15), Luke Donald ('12), Gary Woodland ('11), Jim Furyk ('10), KJ Choi ('02 & '06).

Helpful Information



Autograph Policy

Players may be approached for autographs after their round in the Tampa Bay Times Autograph Alley by the 1st Tee Scoring Area.

Bicycle Parking

The Valspar Championship is a bicycle-friendly tournament. Be more environmentally friendly and avoid the shuttles - ride your bike to the event! Bike racks will be available at Gate 1 and Gate 4. Please note, the tournament is not liable for any stolen or damaged items.

First Aid and EMS Services

Provided by Tampa General Hospital, located near the 18th Green. In the event of an accident or injury on the golf course, proceed to First Aid or contact a Gallery Management Ambassador or Tournament Official with a radio. They will contact First Aid or EMS to assist you.

Pairings Guides will be available at each admission gate as well as digitally via the Valspar Championship mobile app.

Lost & Found Items

Lost & Found is located at the main information booth near the 1st Tee. Lost & Found items may be picked up prior to 6 p.m. on the day they are lost. All items not picked up prior to 6 p.m. on the day they are lost will be taken to the Tournament Office. To report or inquire about lost & found items, please call 727.942.5566.

Mobile Device/Cell Phone Policy

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used.
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio & photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g. personal social media); no commercial use.
- No livestreaming or real-time coverage (e.g. no shot-by-shot coverage) is permitted.
- Data use (e.g. texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies, or media.
- All posted signage & instructions from tournament staff must be observed.
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in revocation of your ticket.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

Mobility-Impaired Spectators

Parking for spectators with state-issued blue parking hang-tags is located in the Red Lot. See ValsparChampionship.com for details. Special viewing platforms for spectators in wheelchairs are located at Hole 18. For the safety of all concerned, it is suggested that those using wheelchairs or similar transport use the hard-surfaced roads, cart paths, and flat observation areas as much as possible. The grass is often damp and becomes very slippery on sloped areas. Limited on-course mobility shuttles will be available.

Players

The players have until 5 p.m. EST on the Friday of the week preceding the tournament to officially commit to playing in the Valspar Championship. For an up-to-date list, please visit ValsparChampionship.com.

Prohibited Items

- No autographed memorabilia
- No backpacks, seat cushions, or coolers of any kind
- No opaque bags (in their natural state)
- No clear tote bags, plastic vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x6" 12"
- No chair bags (folding chairs are permitted, but the sleeves that hold them are not)
- No lawn or oversized chairs
- No pets except for service animals
- No video cameras at any time
- No cameras or GoPros after Wednesday (camera lens must fit within 6"x6" restrictions)
- No selfie sticks
- No computers or laptops
- No whistles, horns or noisemakers
- No radios, televisions or other electronic noise producing items
- No signs, banners, poles or rods
- No alcoholic beverages may enter or leave the tournament
- No outside food or beverages may enter the tournament except for medical or infant needs
- No plastic, metal or glass cups or containers except for medical or infant needs
- No weapons of any kind may enter the tournament including, but not limited to, firearms or knives
- No fireworks or laser pointers
- No illegal substances
- No other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the PGA TOUR Tournament Security Officials.

All items are subject to search. There is no check tent, so you will be asked to return all unauthorized items to your car before you are allowed to board shuttles. Tournament is not responsible for personal items left unattended.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

Rideshare

Uber/Lyft drop-off and pick-up is located at the Green Lot. See ValsparChampionship.com for details.

Safety

For your personal safety, we ask that you exercise due care at all times.

- Remember to bring sun protection (lotion, hat, sunglasses), or visit the Tampa General Hospital/USF Health Sunscreen Stations for complimentary sunscreen
- Please do not step under or over ropes
- Never cross fairways except at designated cross-over areas
- Please be sure to read Assumption of Risk information located on your ticket and at ValsparChampionship.com

Severe Weather

The PGA TOUR will monitor the weather daily during tournament week. In the event of thunderstorms, lightning or other severe weather, "Weather Warning" information will be displayed on the electronic scoreboards around the golf course. When these warnings appear, fans are advised to take precautions and seek shelter immediately. The electronic scoreboards will keep fans advised as to the length of the delay in play; however, in the event of severe weather or lightning, avoid the following areas: bleachers, tall or isolated trees, hill tops or other high areas, open fields, golf carts, lakes and pods, metal fences, barricades, hospitality venues, etc.

Suggested Attire

Appropriate casual golf wear with comfortable walking shoes (soft spikes only) is recommended. Spectators should have these items on hand: windbreaker, hat/visor, sunscreen, sunglasses and umbrella.
