Safety

For your personal safety, we ask that you exercise due care at all times. Remember to bring sun protection (lotion, hat, sunglasses) and a comfortable pair of shoes. Complimentary sunscreen lotion is available at the Tampa General Hospital Sunscreen Stations. Please do not step under or over ropes. Never cross fairways except at designated crossover areas. Please be sure to read the Assumption of Risk section located on your ticket and at ValsparChampionship.com.

First Aid and EMS Services

Provided by Tampa General Hospital and located by the 18th green. In the event of an accident or injury on the golf course, proceed to First Aid or contact a Gallery Marshal or Tournament Official with a radio. They will contact First Aid or EMS to assist you.

Severe Weather

The PGA TOUR will monitor the weather daily during tournament week. In the event of thunderstorms, lightning or other severe weather, "Weather Warning" information will be displayed on the electronic scoreboards around the golf course. When these warnings appear, fans are advised to take precautions and seek shelter immediately. The electronic scoreboards will keep fans advised as to the length of the delay in play; however, in the event of severe weather or lightning, avoid the following areas: bleachers, tall or isolated trees, hill tops or other high areas, open fields, golf carts, lakes and ponds, metal fences, barricades, hospitality venues, etc.

Mobility-Impaired Spectators

Parking for spectators with state-issued Blue parking hangtags is located in the Red Lot. See ValsparChampionship.com for details. ADA-accessible shuttles are available from Red Lot directly to the main clubhouse. Special viewing platforms for spectators in wheelchairs are located at the 18th green and 1st tee. For the safety of all concerned, it is suggested that those using wheelchairs or similar transport use the hard-surfaced roads, cart paths and flat observation areas as much as possible. The grass is often damp and becomes very slippery on sloped areas. Limited on-course mobility shuttles will be available throughout the course.

Players

The players have until 5 p.m. on the Friday of the week preceding the tournament to officially commit to playing in the Valspar Championship. For an up-to-date list, please visit ValsparChampionship.com.

Youth Policy

Children ages 15 and under are admitted free of charge with a properly credentialed adult. Tickets required for anyone 3 years and older to access hospitality areas, including the Snake Pit Club venues, DEX DECK and Hooters Owl's Nest.

Military Policy

Active Duty and Retired US Military personnel receive free grounds admission; Veterans can purchase tickets at discounted rate. Active Duty, Retired and Veterans are allowed access to the Pinch A Penny Patriots' Outpost hospitality tent at the 4th green. Visit ValsparChampionship.com for details.

Rideshare drop-off and pick-up is located at the Yellow Lot, near Gate 8.

Mobile Device/Cellphone Policy

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage)
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in revocation of your ticket

Lost & Found Items

Lost & Found will be located at the main Information tent near the 1st tee. Lost & Found items may be picked up prior to 6 p.m. on the day they are lost. All items not picked up prior to 6 p.m. on the day they are lost will be taken to the Tennis Center located at 36750 U.S. Highway 19 N., Palm Harbor, FL 34684. To report or inquire about Lost & Found items, please call 727-942-5566.

Prohibited Items

- No bags larger than 6"x6"x6", including carrying cases, backpacks, camera bags or coolers
- No clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items larger than 12"x6"x12"
- No chair bags (folding chairs are permitted, but the sleeves that hold them are not)
- No lawn or oversized chairs or extended footrests
- No pets except for service animals
- No video cameras at any time
- No cameras or GoPros after Wednesday (camera lens must fit within 6"x6" restrictions)
- No selfie sticks or hand-held camera stabilizers
- No computers or laptops
- No whistles, horns or noisemakers
- No radios, televisions or other electronic noise-producing items
- No signs, banners, poles or rods
- No alcoholic beverages may enter or leave the tournament
- No outside glass cups/bottles may enter the tournament except for medical or infant needs
- No weapons of any kind may enter the tournament, including, but not limited to, firearms or knives
- No fireworks or laser pointers
- No memorabilia items, such as flags and photos
- No motorcycles, mopeds, tricycles, bicycles, skateboards, hoverboards or similar items will be permitted on or within tournament property
- No drones, remote-controlled model aircrafts or other devices can be operated in airspace
- No other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the PGA TOUR Tournament Security Officials

All items are subject to search. There is no check tent, so you will be asked to return all unauthorized items to your car before you are allowed to board shuttles. Tournament is not responsible for personal items left unattended.

Autograph Policy

During official competitive rounds (Thursday-Sunday), a player cannot sign autographs after the start of his round until it is complete. The Tampa Bay Times Autograph Alley is located near the 1st tee/scoring area. Players have the option to use this area.
